Buyers of the shares seek remedy against the misleading statement will they succeed?
- e) J stole a number of cheques belonging to Gopal endorsed them to himself and paid them into his account with C Bank. In each case money was immediately credited to his account and he was either allowed to withdraw the money or his overdraft wiped out before the cheque could be cleared. Gopal sues the bank for wrongful conversion of funds will he succeed?
